Scope: Catalonia

Univers: Spanish citizens of 18 years of age and more who live in Catalonia

Method of data collection:

Computer Assisted Telephone Interview (CATI)

Sampling procedure:

Stratified by province and size of the municipality with random selection of sampling units using sex, age and place of birth crossed quotas, and an additional quota for the whole sample by household type: with landline or cellular phone.

Town size is divided into 6 categories: less or equal to 2,000 inhabitants; from 2,001 and 10,000 inhabitants; from 10,001 and 50,000 inhabitants; from 50,001 and 150,000 inhabitants; from 150,001 and 1,000,000 inhabitants; more than 1 million inhabitants.

To calculate the quotas we use the official statistics from the *Padró continu de població* from the year 2018. The age quotas correspond to the following intervals: 18 to 24 years of age; 25 to 34 years of age; 35 to 49 years of age; 50 to 64 years of age ; 65 and more years of age.

Weighting:

At the end of the fieldwork of this survey following the scheduled calendar, we detected a slight mismatch between the final sample obtained and the initial theoretical sample.

For this reason, with the purpose of adjusting the sample obtained to the initial theoretical sample, a post-stratification weight has been applied. The figures for the calculation of the coefficients of the weights have been provided by the IDESCAT and belong to the *Padró Continu d'Habitants 2018*. The coefficients are the following:

Sampling error:

The overall margin of error of the survey is ± 3.10 , for a confidence level of 95% (1.96 sigma) and under the assumption of maximum indetermination ($p=q=50\%$) and considering a simple random sample design. In each province the margins of error are:

- Barcelona ± 3.59
- Girona ± 10.11
- Lleida ± 13.10
- Tarragona ± 9.66

Fieldwork:

The fieldwork has been performed by GESOP. Gabinet d'Estudis Socials i Opinió Pública, SL from the 30th of April to the 6th of May 2019.

Methodological note:

1. In the time series graphs, the data of December 2016 corresponded to the Survey about the Political Context in Catalonia 2016, which was a CATI survey. The rest refer to the different waves of the Political Opinion Barometer that since 2014 is a CAPI survey.
2. When presenting the results of question 7, the different political parties or coalitions were grouped from the point of view of the parliamentary groups that arose after the last elections in the Parliament of Catalonia on December 21, 2017. The result of this grouping has been:

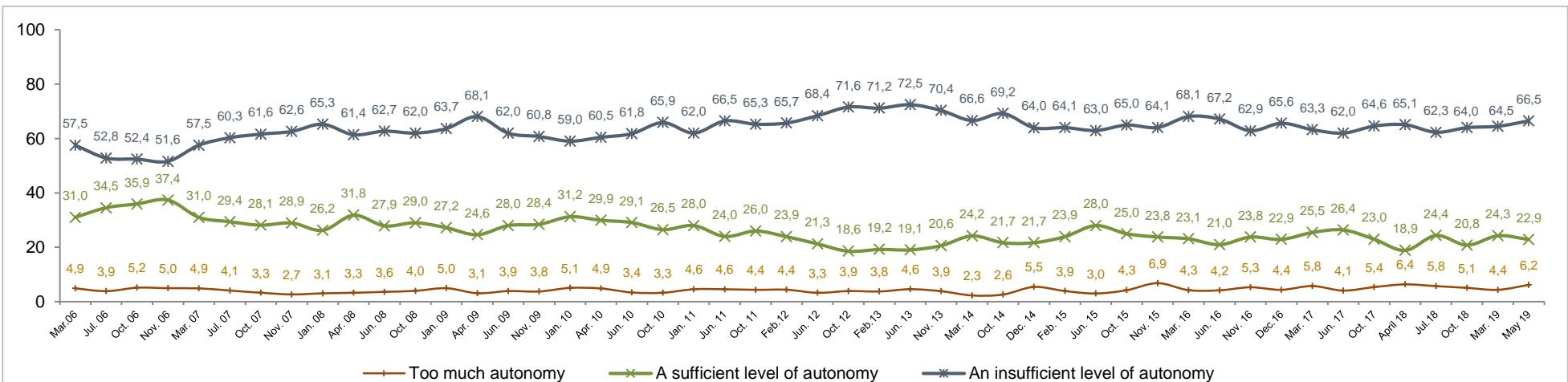
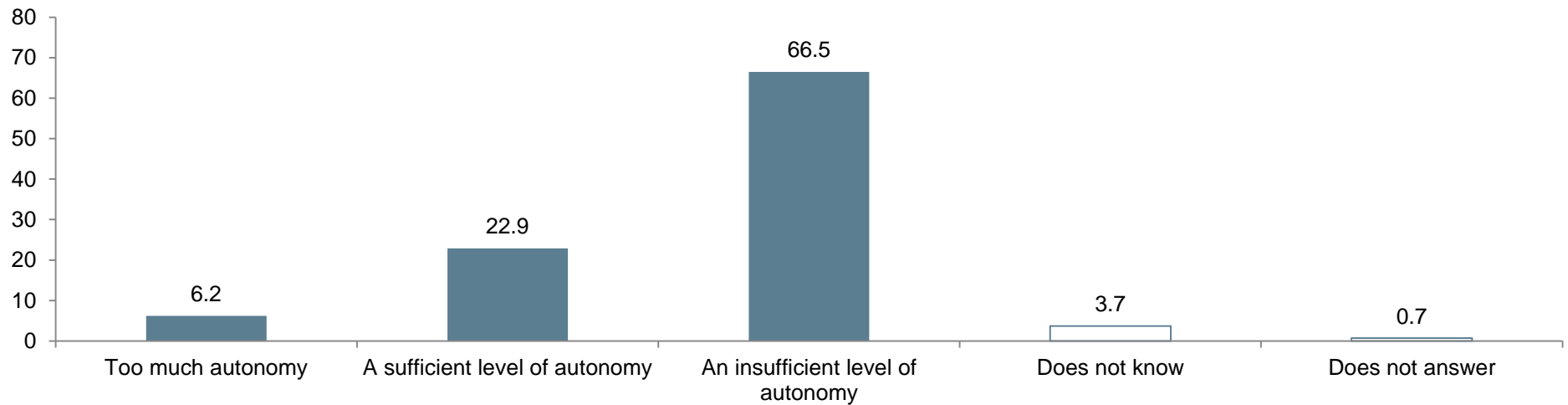

Do you think that Catalonia has achieved...

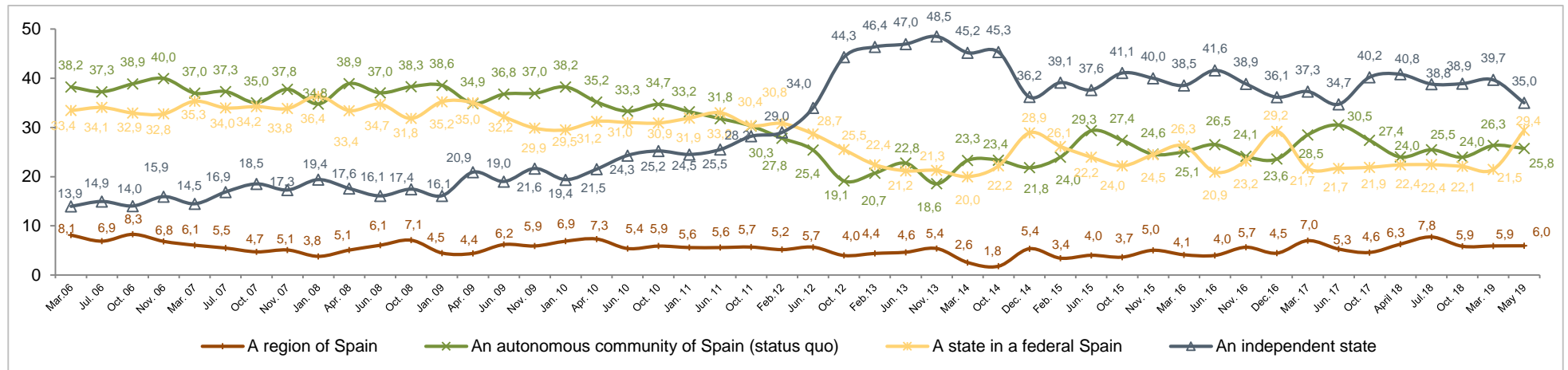
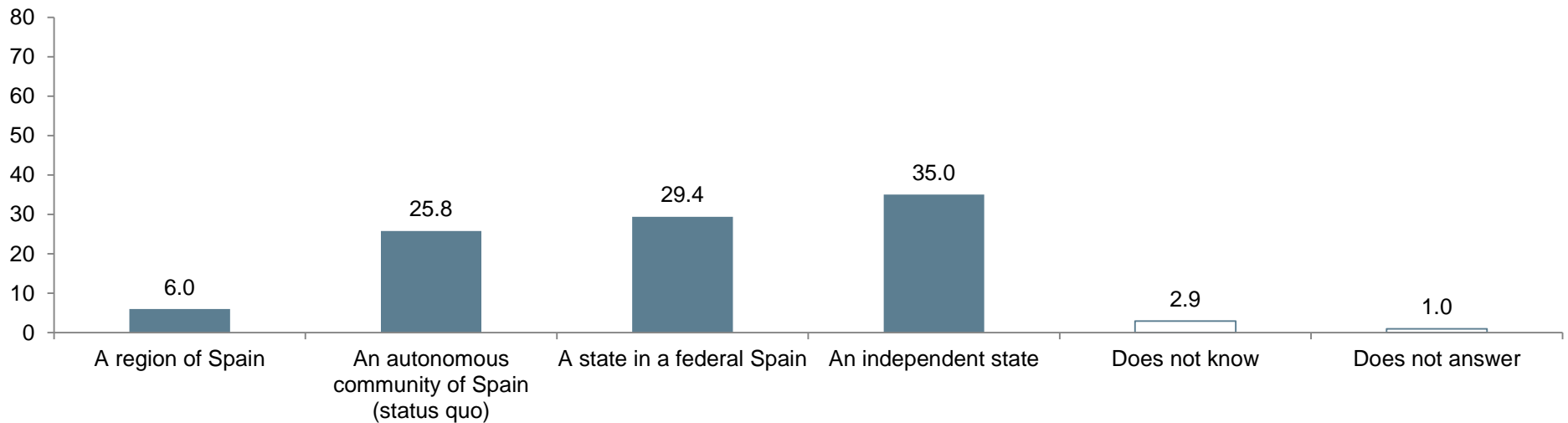

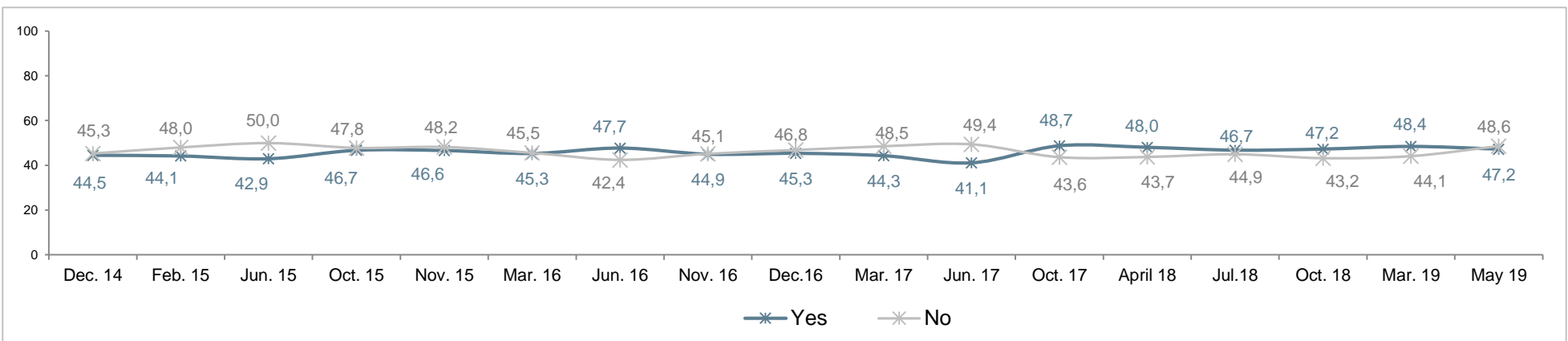

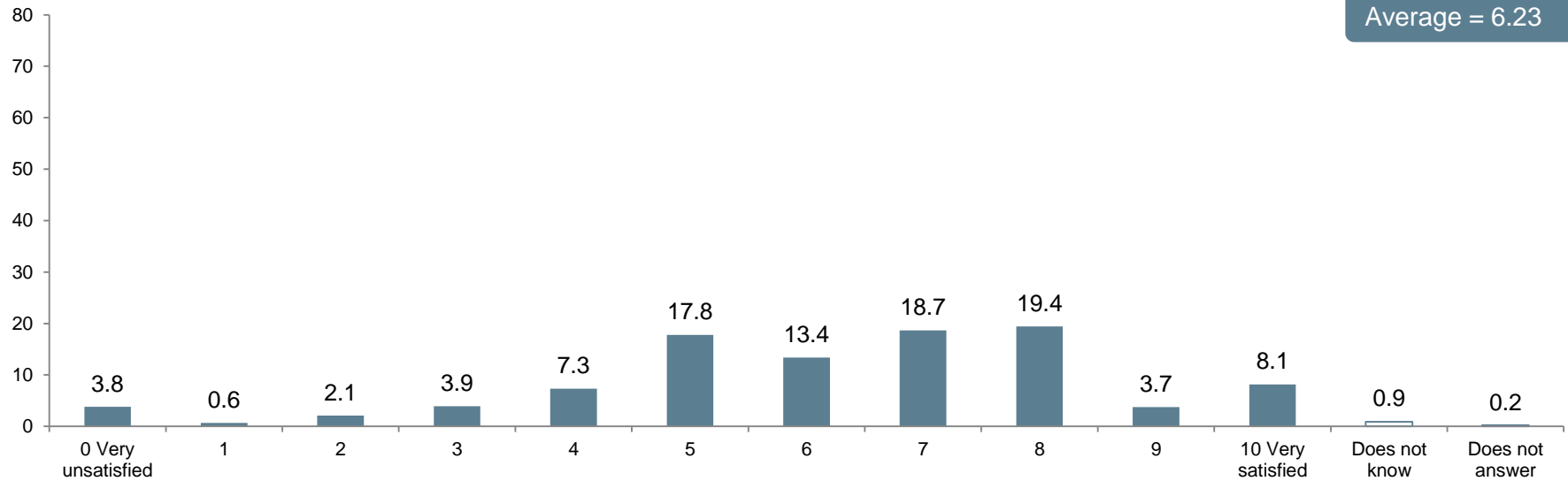

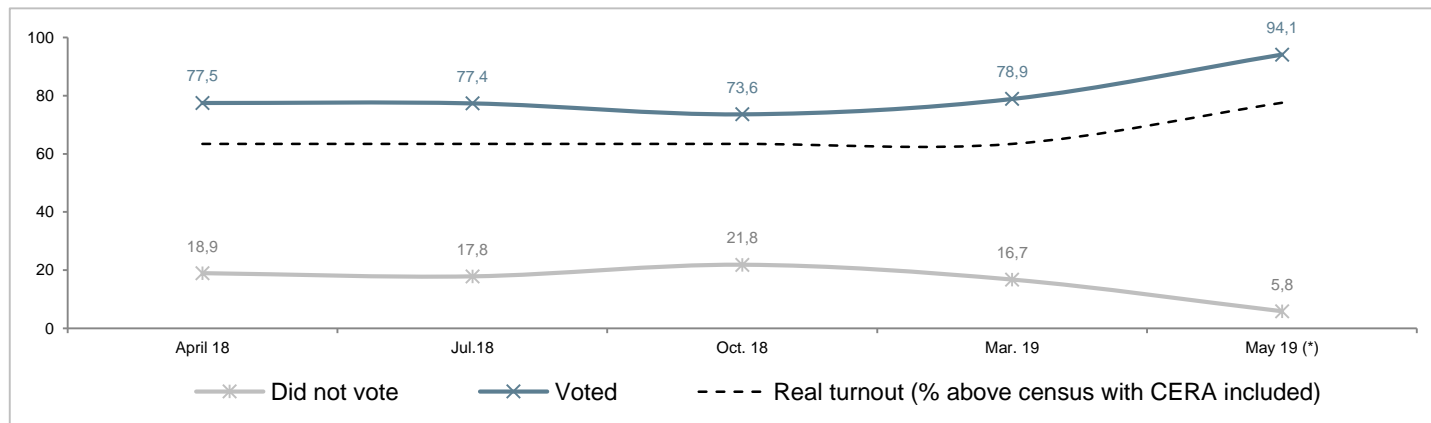

(N=1,000; simple response; %)



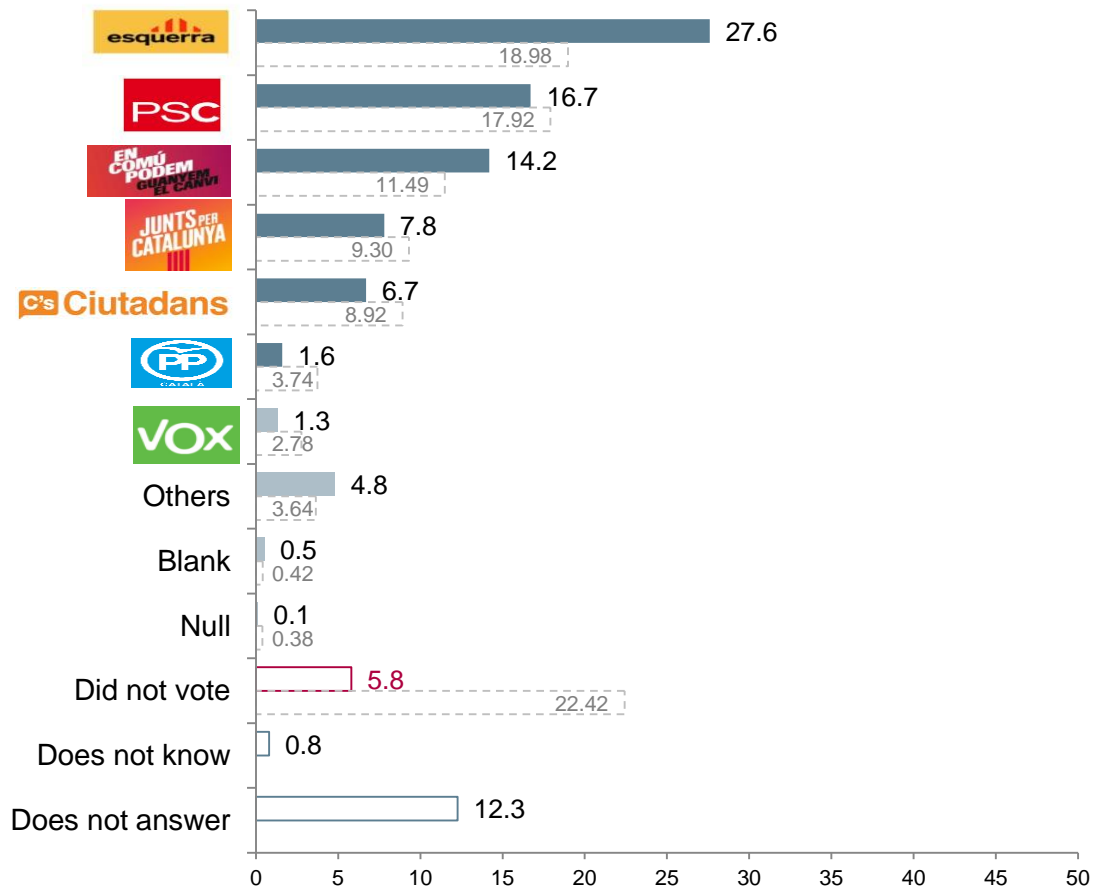

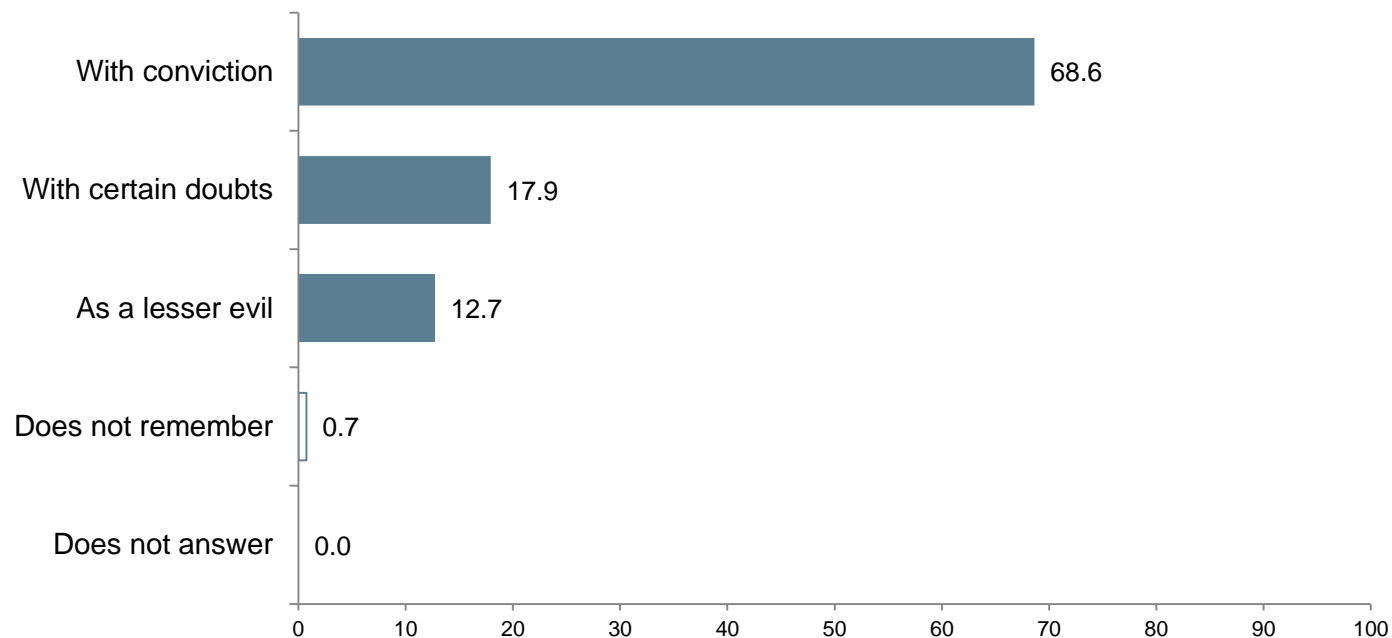

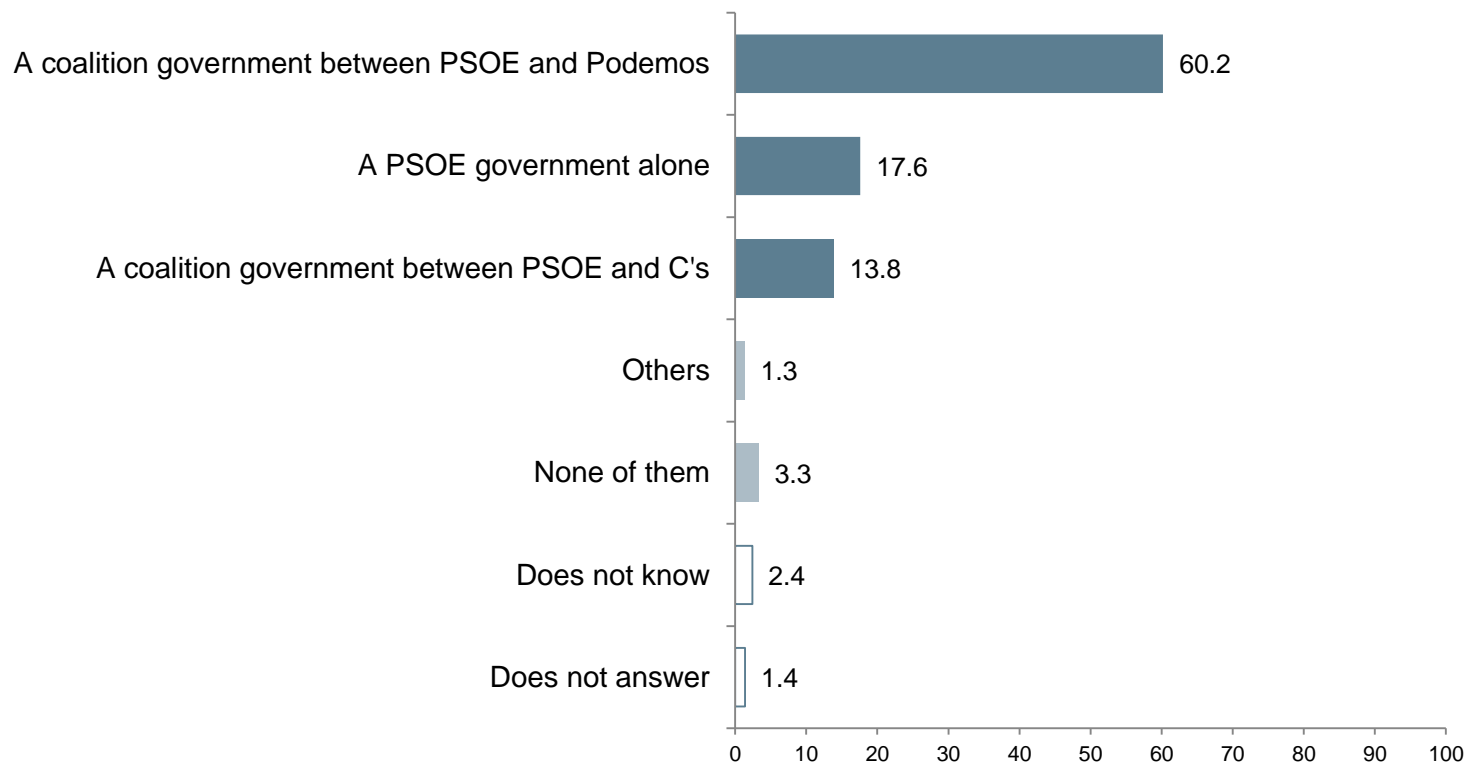

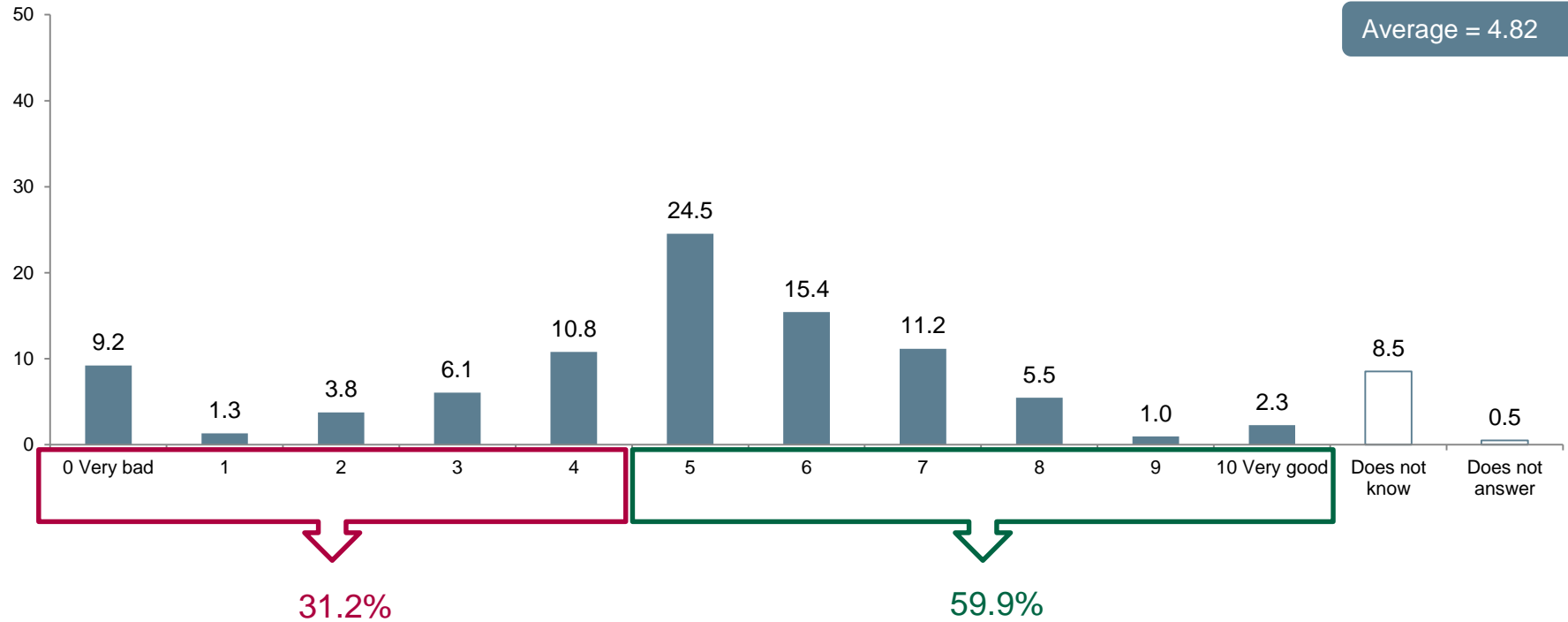

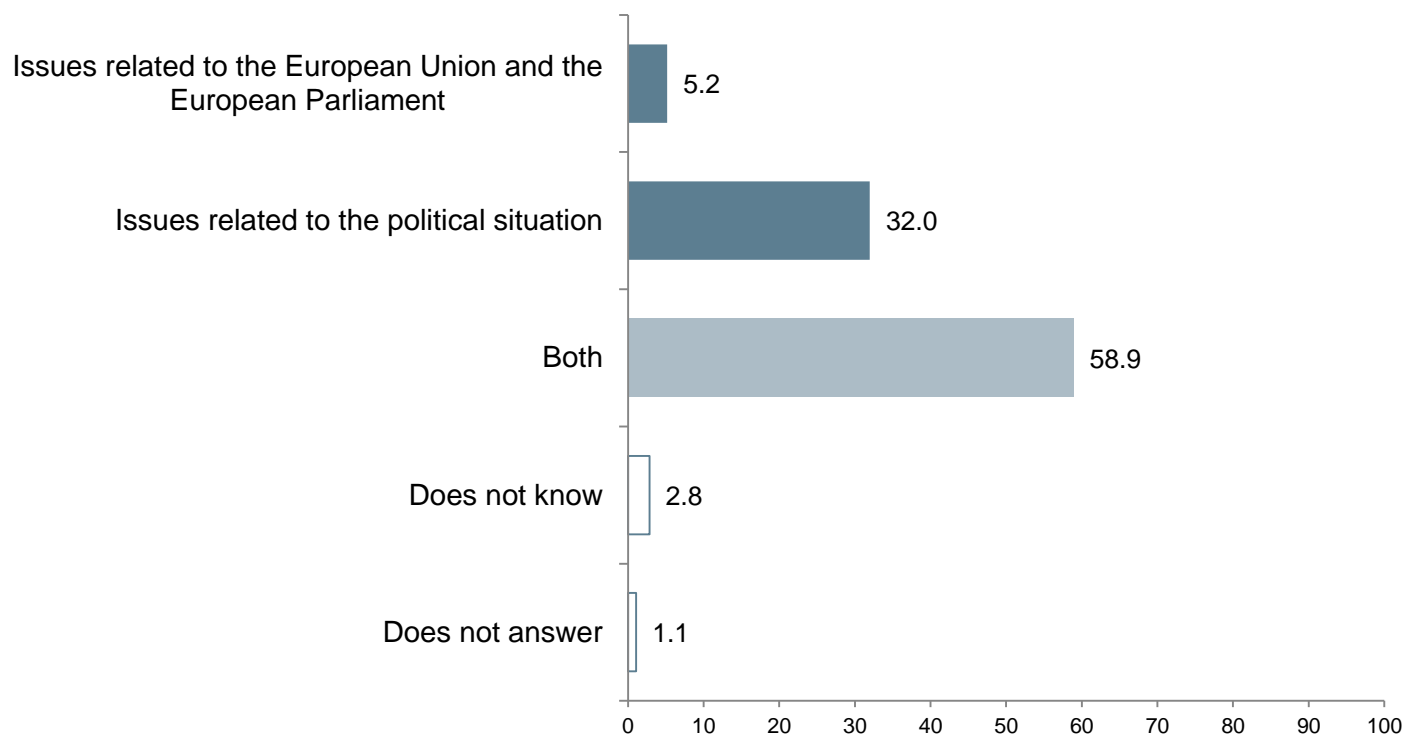

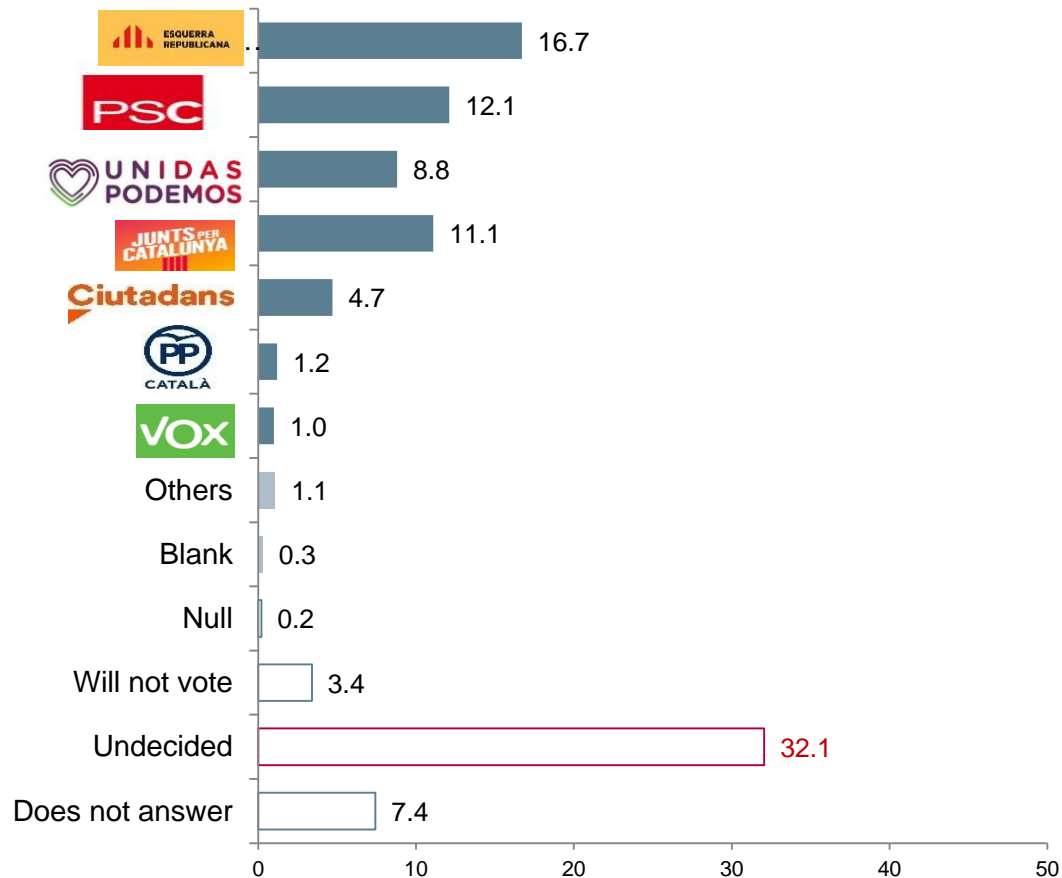
